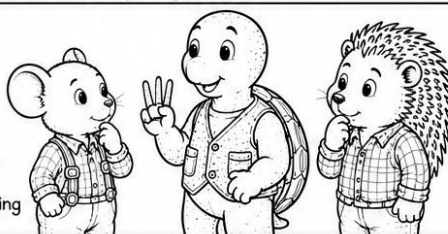
Let's think about the story together.

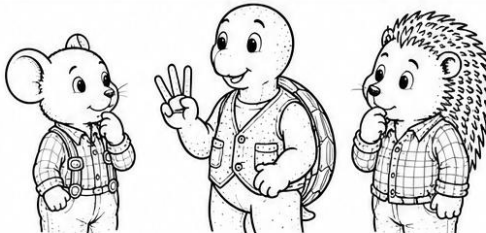

Let's think about what might happen.

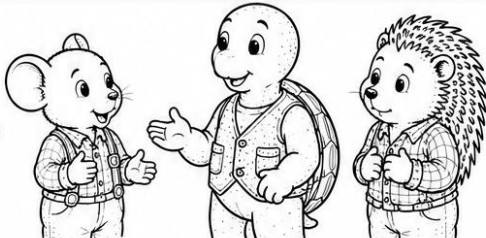
- What might Spencer try when Lex's energy feels fast?

Comprehension

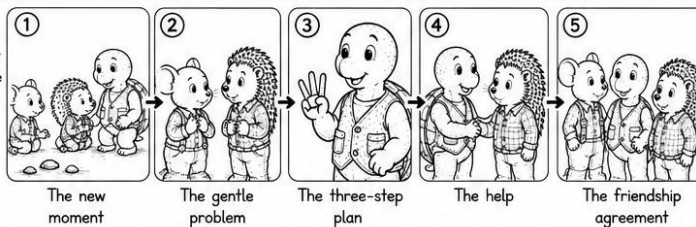
Let's look closer at the story.
