

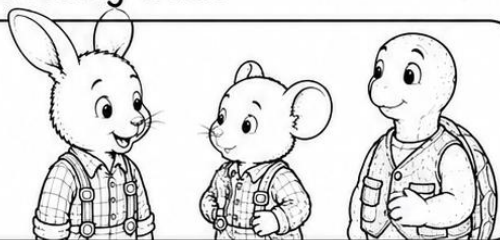


Brandon's Fair Choice



Family and Classroom Reading Guide

- **Reading guidance:** Publisher positioning is ages 3–7 and Preschool–Grade 2; no exact standardized level is verified.
- **Story engine:** Emotional-tool arc: treasured object → possessive feeling → visible need → three-step fairness tool → child-owned sharing action → trust.



Before reading

Invite children to notice Brandon's acorn and wonder why something special can make a choice harder.

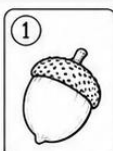

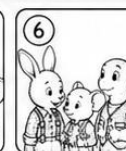

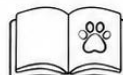
