Reading Guidance

Publisher-positioned for **ages 3–7** and **Preschool–Grade 2**. Verify age and grade recommendations before publication.

Story Structure

An emotional-tool story arc centered on a **child-owned repair**:

- Notice
- Tell the truth
- Repair
- Welcome

Vocabulary Focus

- include
- truth
- repair
- belonging
- comfortable

Group Discussion

Use hypothetical story examples rather than personal experiences, and protect children's privacy. Participation may include speaking, pointing, eye gaze, or partner-supported responses.

Library Use

Well suited for read-alouds paired with books about:

- friendship
- belonging
- inclusion
- making caring repairs after mistakes

Classroom Use

Follow the story with brief activities such as:

- making a prediction before reading,
- sequencing the major story events,
- noticing important story objects and settings,
- discussing the repair steps using hypothetical situations.

Avoid behavior charts, public scoring, required personal sharing, or activities that pressure children to disclose their own mistakes.
