Reading Guidance

Publisher-positioned for **ages 3–7** and **Preschool–Grade 2**. Verify age and grade recommendations before publication.

Story Structure

An emotional-tool story arc combined with a practical teamwork problem-solving arc.

Vocabulary Focus

- cooperation
- role
- safety
- accessible
- test
- together

Group Discussion

Use hypothetical story situations to encourage discussion while protecting children's privacy. Participation may include speaking, pointing, eye gaze, or partner-supported responses.

Library Use

Pairs well with read-alouds about:

- teamwork,
- listening,
- accessibility,
- inclusion,
- and collaborative problem solving.

Classroom Use

Follow the story with activities such as:

- making predictions before reading,
- sequencing the story events,
- recognizing the different roles each character chose,
- and noticing how the plan became more accessible for everyone.

Avoid activities that involve building a device, assigning public jobs, requiring children to speak, or scoring participation.
